Design/Build services for the design and construction improvements of various roadway surfaces at Big Stone National Wildlife Refuge. Most of the roads had subgrade issues in the wetlands area. AACON raised sections of the roadway, added water flow devices, culverts, riprap, and parking areas with new topcoats.
